- #2025-336. A Work Session for a Victim Services Presentation** - *presented by Christina Perry-Rock, Victim Assistance Coordinator*
- Christina Perry-Rock, Victim Assistance Coordinator, gave a presentation on the services provided to crime victims throughout the County [see Attachment A]. In the presentation, she provided statistics on the types of crimes in Davis County from 2023 to the present and summaries of several cases she has assisted in personally. The advocates work to help the victims feel like they are seen, and they are supported through the process.
- After the presentation, Commissioner Kamalu asked what other departments throughout the County have Victim Services other than the County Attorney's Office. Christina indicated that most police departments in the County have a Victim Advocate on staff. Director Bone asked what her office does for self-care given the traumatic nature of the cases seen. Christina stated that having a certain personality, a well-functioning office, communicating with others to decompress, and being able to delineate their work from their personal lives are all ways of dealing with the stress of her office. Commissioner Crofts stated that PEHP Insurance had stopped covering therapy for crime victims and asked how Crime Victim Reparations were handling the increased financial strain. Christina stated that the reparations are receiving less and less funding each year, and there is a constant fight for more funding.

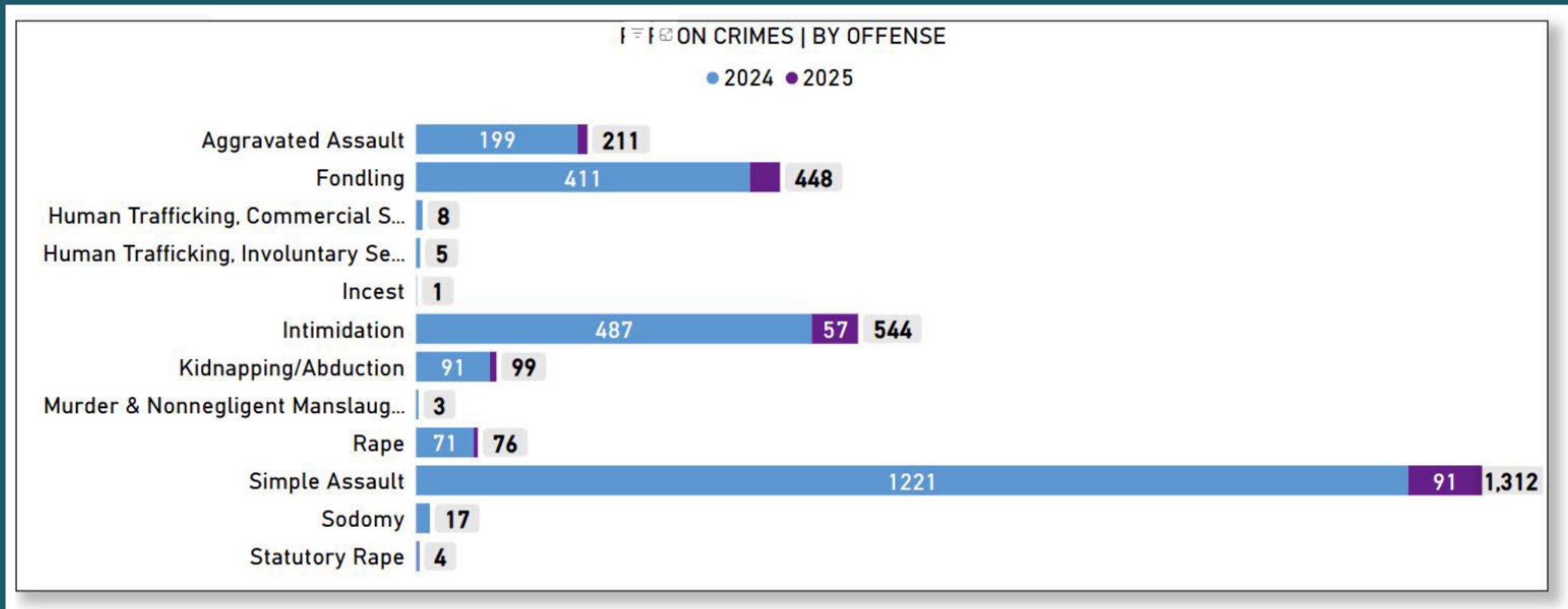

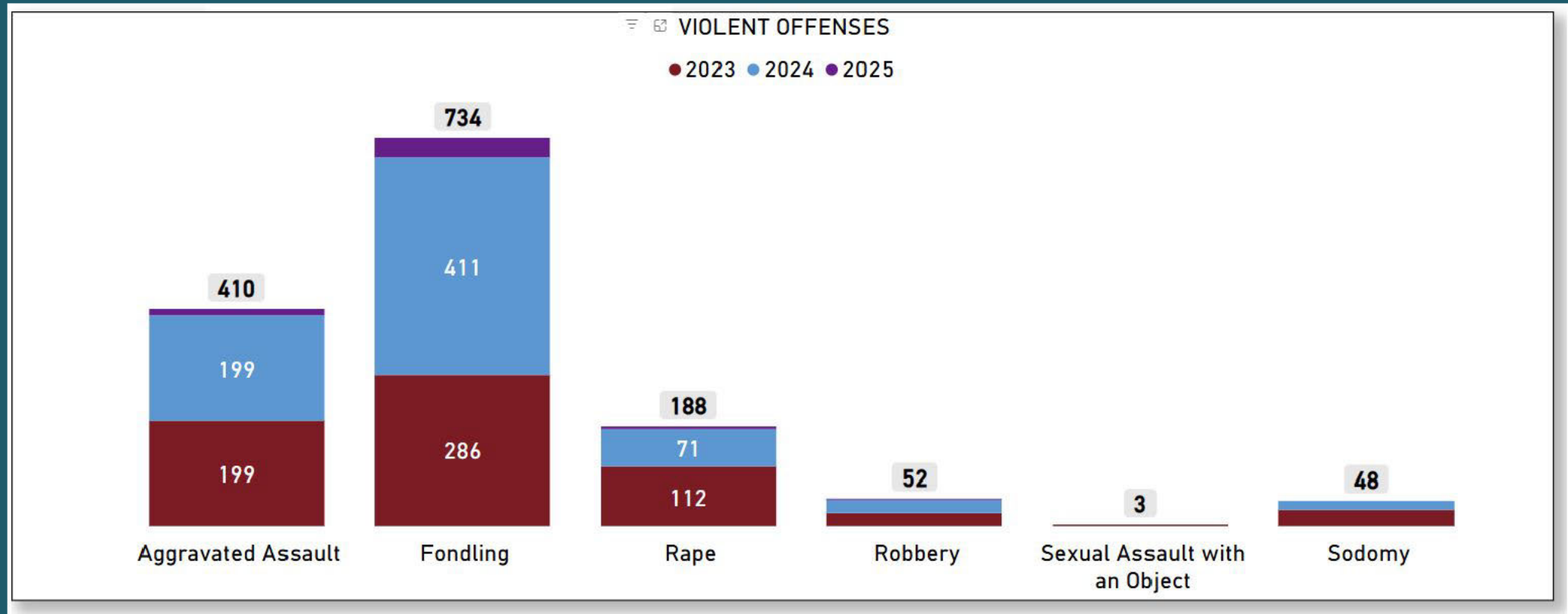

Davis County – Violent Crime 2023- present

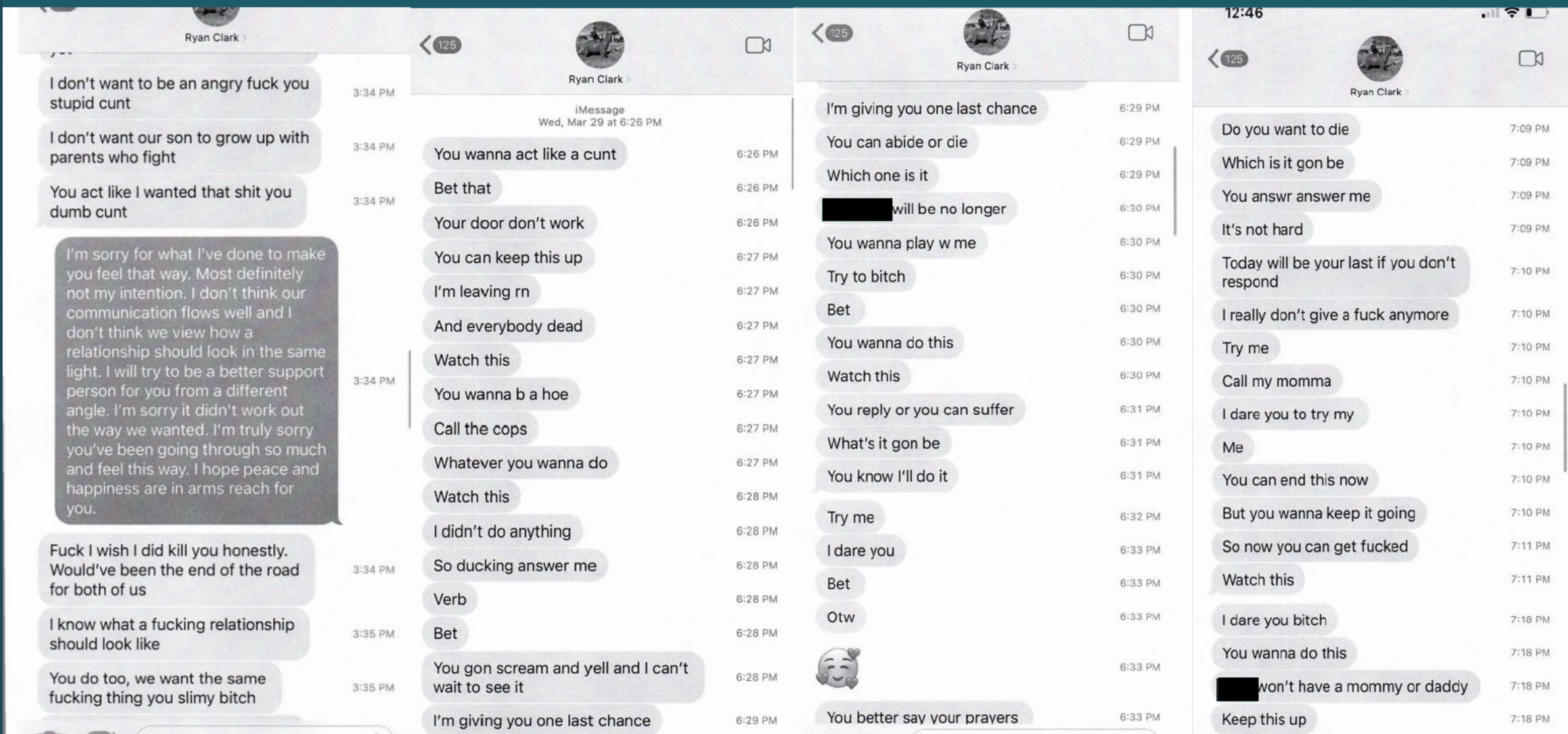

In Conclusion

- Victim Services provide support, referrals to outside resources, a sense of stability, and a person to reach out to as victims navigate a complex, highly variable, and emotionally tumultuous criminal justice system.
- Victim Services do not only seek to protect victim rights, but to provide a pathway to recovery from traumatic and life-altering events.
- Victim Services should be trauma-informed and personalized to the needs and abilities of the victims served.
- Davis County Attorney's Office has a unique approach to victim services, as we seek to provide notification and support to victims of all crime types (whereas the majority of counties do not provide these services outside of violent crime). Violent crimes take up the majority of our time, but we seek to serve all victims, including businesses or the State.

 - Needs of victims of non-violent crime – to be informed of rights regarding restitution, to be aware of how civil remedies may impact criminal proceedings, etc.
